Re: Water Main Replacement Project
Evergreen Road/Ross Township

Dear Resident:

The West View Water Authority, working in conjunction with the scheduled Allegheny County road paving project will be replacing a portion of the water main on Evergreen Road starting at the intersection with Babcock Boulevard near Rochester Road and ending at the intersection with the McKnight Road south off ramp. The project will commence during the week of March 25th.

As with any construction project there will be certain inconveniences. There will be at least two (2) planned interruptions of your water service as we connect the new water main to our existing facilities and when we transfer your existing service line to the new water main. These interruptions may last up to eight (8) hours, and we will notify you in advance of any planned service interruptions. Authority personnel and the Authority contractor will try to keep these inconveniences to a minimum, and we ask for your cooperation.

All areas disturbed by the Authority or its water line contractor will be restored in accordance with Allegheny County, Ross Township, or Authority requirements. Restoration will take place when practical and as weather permits.

Traffic will be maintained along Evergreen Road during the work day. Our contractor will try to keep all interruptions to a minimum and we again ask for your patience and cooperation.

Access to your property may be blocked for a few hours as we install the new water main in front of your property. If a special medical need requires you to have access to your property, please notify me immediately so we may work out the details.

Throughout the duration of the project, the road will be maintained in passable condition. Our final restoration will take place after the new water main has been installed and all customers have been transferred to the new facility. Allegheny County will complete final paving restoration following the Authority's work.
